

# How to Grow Bidens



**Position** – Full sun

**Soil** – Well-drained

**Flowering Period** – Late spring to late autumn

**Hardiness** – Half hardy

## Where to plant Bidens



Bidens are best planted in a well-drained soil of loam, chalk, clay or sand within an acidic, alkaline or neutral PH balance. They are best positioned in either a sheltered or exposed area that receives full sun. Bidens are well suited to growing in containers and borders and make good groundcover.

## How to plant Bidens



Water well after planting. Soil may need to be amended with grit or compost to ensure good drainage.

## How to care for Bidens



Apply a mulch in autumn. Plants will need to be lifted/containers moved before the first frosts and be kept frost free during winter as they are not fully hardy. Deadhead to prolong flowering.

## How to propagate Bidens



It is possible to propagate Bidens by stem cuttings in the spring or in the autumn or by seed.
