

How to Grow Fatsia



Position – Full sun, part shade or full shade

Soil – Moist but well-drained

Flowering Period – Autumn

Hardiness – Fully Hardy

Where to plant Fatsia



Fatsia are best planted in a moist but well-drained soil of sand, loam, chalk or clay within an acidic, alkaline or neutral PH balance. They can be positioned in an area of full sun, part shade or full shade. Fatsia are well suited to banks and slopes within an architectural, courtyard or cottage garden styles.

How to plant Fatsia



Enrich the planting area with a generous amount of compost before planting. Plant your Fatsia to the same depth and width as the root ball and water thoroughly to settle the soil into place.

How to care for Fatsia



Annually prune to maintain a bush growth habit and to promote healthy, glossy leaves. Provide a generous amount of water during periods of drought, ensuring the soil is kept moist.

How to propagate Fatsia



It is possible to propagate Fatsia by semi-hardwood cuttings.
